

# City of Phoenix Tribal 12% Revenue Sharing Grants Report & Applications Status

*updated 6/16/2008*

**Tribes who have funded the City of Phoenix**

**Gila River Indian Community (GRIC)** – have annual open application process, next application deadline, August 1, 2008. Request 7 copies of each application. No Intergovernmental agreement (IGA); grant by resolution authority.

**Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC)** – proposals accepted by invitation only. Invitations issued in early summer, applications generally due in July. Contact through Vivian Saunders, Community Intergov and/or Larry Landry and Associates, contract lobbyist. Have an annual IGA.

**Ak-Chin Indian Community** – generally accept applications twice a year; most recent deadline May 30, 2008; anticipate they will have a December 2008 deadline as well. Grants awarded via individual IGAs.

**Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation (FMYN)** –No formal application at this time, most recent deadline, May 15, 2008. Annual IGA.

**\*Per discussions with the Ak-Chin legal counsel, beginning with the December 2007 cycle, the City agreed to sponsor all applications for community groups in Phoenix that spoke directly to the Tribal Secretary and received a copy of the application from the Community. IGP did not make the application available to anyone outside of a city department. Per legal counsel, the tribe requires city sponsorship be sought by the applicant and that all proposals bear the signature of the Mayor prior to submission to be eligible for review.**
